Sanitary Sewage Overflow Notification Summary Report

Attach additional information as necessary to explain or document each overflow occurrence. A single SSO may be more than one day if the circumstance causing the overflow results in discharge duration more than 24 hours. If there is a stop and restart of the overflow within 24 hours, but it's caused by the same circumstances, report it as one SSO. If discharges are separated by more than 24 hours, they should be reported as separate SSO's
