Certified Journeyman Line Worker

The Cumberland Municipal Utility is now accepting applications for the position of Certified Journeyman Line Worker. This full-time position is a key role within the Electric Utility Department and is responsible for the construction, operation, maintenance, and repair of the City's overhead and underground electric distribution systems. The position also assists other utility departments as needed and participates in an on-call rotation for emergency response. A full job description can be found on our website at <https://cityofcumberland.net/forms-permits/>. Applicants must possess a high school diploma or equivalent and have successfully completed an electrical lineman apprenticeship. A valid Journeyman Line worker certification is required. Applicants must hold a valid Wisconsin driver's license and possess, or be able to obtain, a Class "A" CDL within six (6) months of hire. Strong knowledge of electrical safety procedures, mechanical aptitude, basic computer skills, and effective communication skills are required. Applicants must be able to lift a minimum of 50 pounds and perform physically demanding work.

The selected candidate must participate in an on-call rotation with a reasonable response time to the Utility Shop during emergencies and successfully complete a pre-employment physical, drug and alcohol screening, and background check. Compensation will be based on qualifications and experience, with a starting wage of \$47.93 per hour. An increase will be provided following the successful completion of a six-month probationary period, with an additional increase at one year. The City of Cumberland also provides annual cost-of-living (CPI) adjustments and performance-based wage increases. Cumberland Municipal Utility offers an excellent benefits package, including participation in the Wisconsin Retirement System, state health insurance, paid vacation, sick leave, and paid time off.

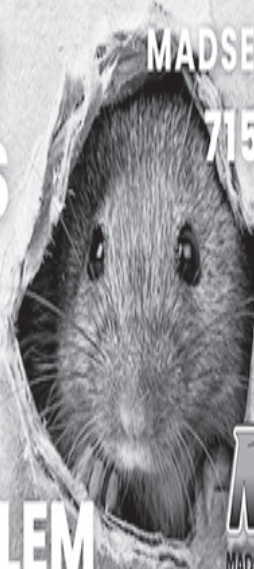

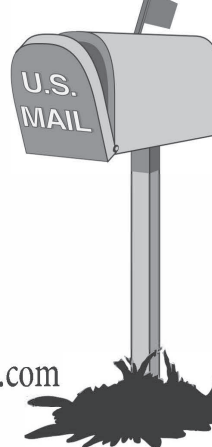
