the suspect kneel down and began selecting items of merchandise off the pegs. The suspect went from peg to peg selecting and setting down the merchandise. When all of the pegs were emptied, the suspect stood up, turned around and concealed the merchandise inside of his jacket pocket. The suspect then proceeded to walk out of the store passing the last point of sale without paying for any of the merchandise he concealed in his jacket.

The sergeant reports that no one associated with Hobby Lobby consented to Gibson stealing the large

number of sterling silver jewelry items that he left the store without paying for. The male added up all of the missing pieces of jewelry. There were 50 items missing, and the total of the stolen merchandise was \$701.50. The stolen merchandise included an assortment of rings, earrings, and necklaces.

The sergeant reports he investigated the retail theft and learned in the course of his investigation that the same suspect had, in November of 2025, stolen merchandise from the Hobby Lobby in Eau Claire. He has a warrant for his arrest.

## Construction on southbound US 53 multi-bridge project to resume; Work in 2026 includes replacing one bridge and rehabbing two other structures

Construction on a multi-year improvement project rehabilitating or replacing bridges on southbound US 53 in Barron County between Cameron and New Auburn is anticipated to resume Monday, Feb. 23; that start is weather dependent.

Construction in 2026 includes:

Replacing the decks on the bridges over the Chetek River and 20th Street

Replacing the bridge over County I

Milling pavement on both sides of each structure and placing new asphalt pavement on the approaches

Milling and overlaying the pavement on the southbound US 53 on- and off-ramps at the County I interchange

Replacing guardrail, pavement markings and signage

Construction in 2025 included replacing the decks on the bridges over County AA and County A and overlaying the decks with concrete on bridges over Carlson School Road, Knapp Street and US 8. All structures were built in 1972.

Once construction resumes, motorists will encounter single-lane closures

in both directions on County I. Work on southbound US 53 is anticipated to begin in early March, and motorists will encounter single-lane closures of the southbound lanes.

The prime contractor on the \$10.7 million project is Zenith Tech, Inc. of Waukesha.

Construction in 2026 is scheduled for completion in October.

## PUBLIC NOTICES

**NOTICE TO ALL DOG OWNERS IN BARRON COUNTY**

Pursuant to Section 174.052 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Barron County Board of Supervisors, through this notice, advises all dog owners in Barron County that state law requires dogs to be vaccinated against rabies and to be licensed. State law defines as an owner anyone who owns, harbors, or keeps a dog.

**Rabies vaccination required.** Section 95.21(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes requires dog owners to have a veterinarian vaccinate each dog against rabies. A dog must be vaccinated no later than 5 months of age, and revaccination required within one year after the initial vaccination. Older dogs already vaccinated must be revaccinated before the vaccination certificate expires or, if the certificate does not specify an expiration date, within 3 years of the previous vaccination.

**Dog licenses.** Section 174.05 requires that dogs 5 months of age or older be licensed annually. The license year begins January 1 and continues through the following December 31. The minimum dog license tax is \$5 for a neutered male dog or spayed female dog (upon presentation of evidence that the dog is neutered or spayed), and \$10 for an unneutered male dog or unsplayed female dog, or one-half of these amounts if the dog became 5 months of age after July 1 of the license year. Multiple dog licenses are \$35 for those that have 12 or fewer dogs and an additional \$5 for each dog in excess of 12. The governing body of any town, village, or city may by resolution raise the minimum dog license tax on dogs within its jurisdiction.

**Penalties.** An owner who fails to have a dog vaccinated against rabies may be required to forfeit not less than \$50 nor more than \$100 for each dog not vaccinated. An owner who fails to obtain a license before April 1 of a license year will be required to pay a late fee of \$5 for each dog not licensed before that date. Failure to license a dog can also result in a fine of up to \$500 or imprisonment in the county jail for as long as 60 days, or both. Failure to license a dog will result in a county ordinance violation in the amount of \$169.00 for the first offense.

**Where to get a license.** Your city, town, or village treasurer issues dog licenses and will require owners to pay the dog license or multiple license tax and to provide evidence of the dog's rabies immunization.
