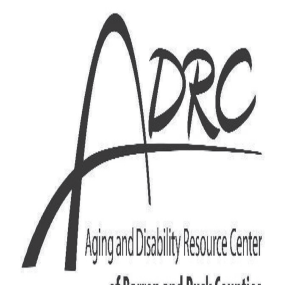

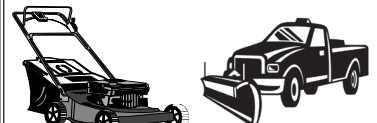

2026 STREET MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Cumberland, Wisconsin, until 4:00pm on Monday June 8, 2026 at Cumberland City Hall, 950 1st Ave., Cumberland, WI 54829, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The City is seeking a unit price bid for various street maintenance treatment options including pulverize & pave, mill & overlay, overlay, crack filling and shouldering. Total treatment area is estimated at 85,000 to 95,000 square yards, and an undetermined linear distance for crack filling and shouldering. In addition to the unit prices on which the award will be based, bidders will be asked for recommended treatment options for the various street segments being considered for the 2026 Street Maintenance Program. The City will compare and contrast the recommendations against each other in order to help determine the final treatment selected for each segment. Questions may be directed to bidders on their recommendations before the bid is awarded.
