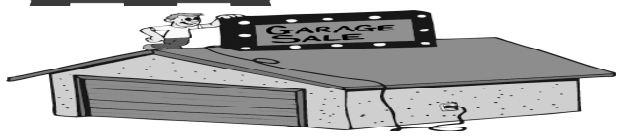

LEGAL NOTICE

Cumberland Federal Bank (the "Bank") has recently published various regulatory notices. To help address any potential questions, Bank management wanted to publish this notice to provide additional clarity regarding the reorganization proposal (the "Proposal"). The Proposal is simply the creation of a holding company structure for the Bank. A vast majority of banks have holding companies. The creation of a holding company structure will not change the Bank's day-to-day operations or offerings; rather, it provides the organization with additional flexibility and tools to remain independent. Customers of the Bank can still expect to receive the same high-quality service and products they receive today. Because the Bank is a heavily regulated institution, the creation of the holding company structure requires (1) regulatory approval along with various required public notices, and (2) approval from our members. In connection with the latter, our members can expect to receive detailed information in the near future.

AQUATIC PLANT MANAGEMENT NOTICE

The Sand Lake Management District is applying for a permit to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for a chemical treatment of Eurasian Water Milfoil (HWM) in up to 5 acres of Sand Lake. Proposed aquatic herbicides to be used is ProcellaCOR, approved for use in Wisconsin. The treatment is expected in June 2024.
A draft of the permit application which includes the treatment sites can be requested by email harmony-env@amerytel.net.
The public may request a public informational meeting within 5 days of this notice by contacting harmony-env@amerytel.net and the Department of Natural Resources, Austin Dehn, 810 W. The Lake District will conduct a public informational meeting on the proposed treatment if five or more individuals, organizations, special units of government, or local units of government request one. The Lake District is not required to, but may, change the proposed treatment based on information provided by citizens who attend the meeting.
