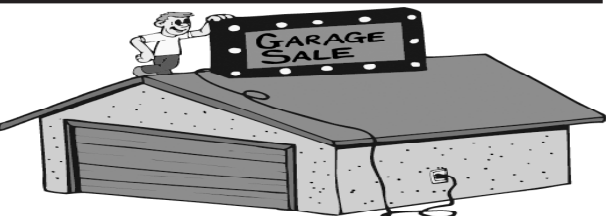

An ordinance amending Section 2.04 Committees.

Motion was made by Skinner, seconded by Rieper, to reconvene to open session to adjourn the meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

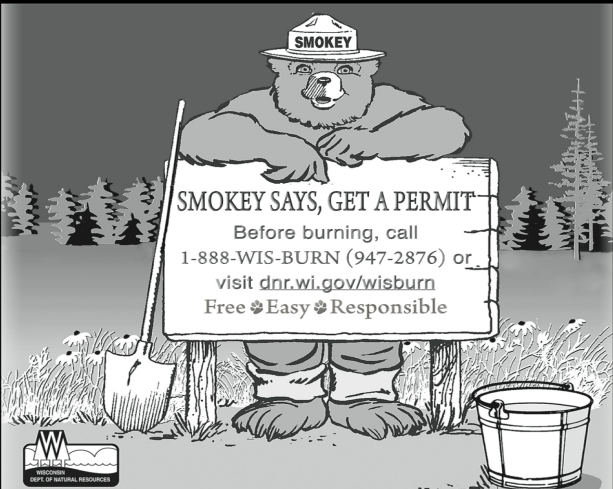
