2. Tax Filing Software. Numerous software options are available, ranging from basic to advanced, offering varying levels of guidance and support.

3. Tax Preparer. Enlisting the help of a qualified tax professional can be beneficial for those with complex tax situations or who prefer personalized assistance.

4. VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance). Free tax preparation assistance is available to eligible taxpayers through the VITA program, offered by community organizations and IRS-certified volunteers. To locate an site near you, use the VITA/TCE Locator Tool or the AARP Site Locator Tool.

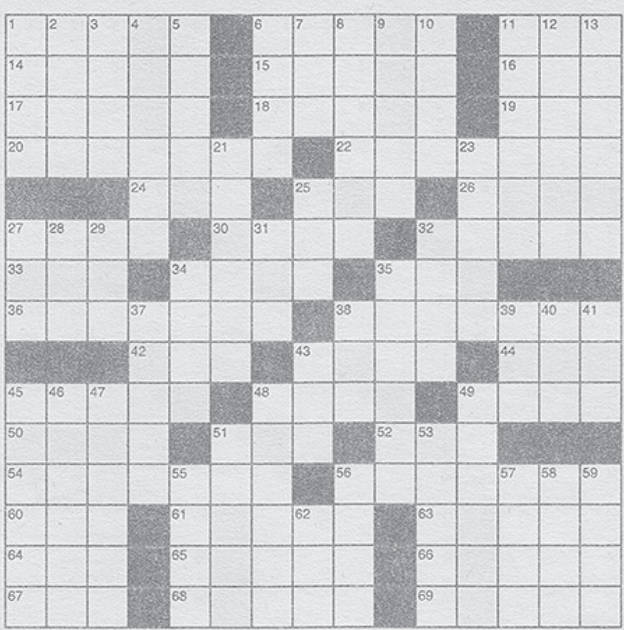
